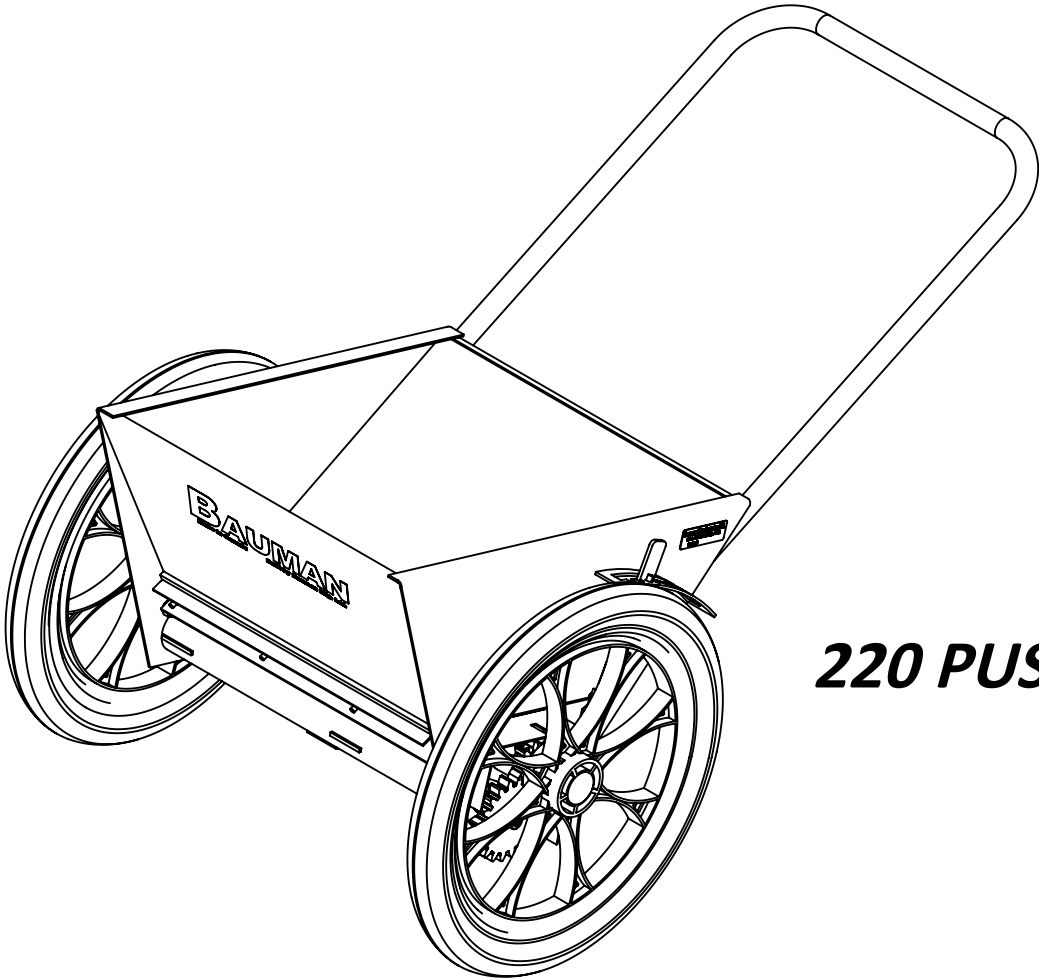

General Information About The Bauman Sidewalk Sander

The operator must read and understand all of the information in this manual to ensure they service and operate the machine correctly and thus avoid unnecessary risk of accidents and breakdowns.

Adjustment

The spring bottom tension is adjusted with the handle on the left side of the machine. Correct adjustment is important as excessive tightening will cause unnecessary wearing to the rubber belt and rotating parts while too much slack will cause uneven spreading distribution.

Starting

Spreading of material starts as soon as the unit is moved forward.

Maintenance

For optimum performance and durability, we recommend frequent and thorough cleaning of the machine. Use plenty of water while cleaning the machine in order to avoid material freezing on the roller and rubber belts. Do not spray water directly into bearings or bearing houses. Bearings must be lubricated regularly. If the machine is stored for a lengthy period of time, it is recommended that it is sprayed with acid-free oil before use.

Safety

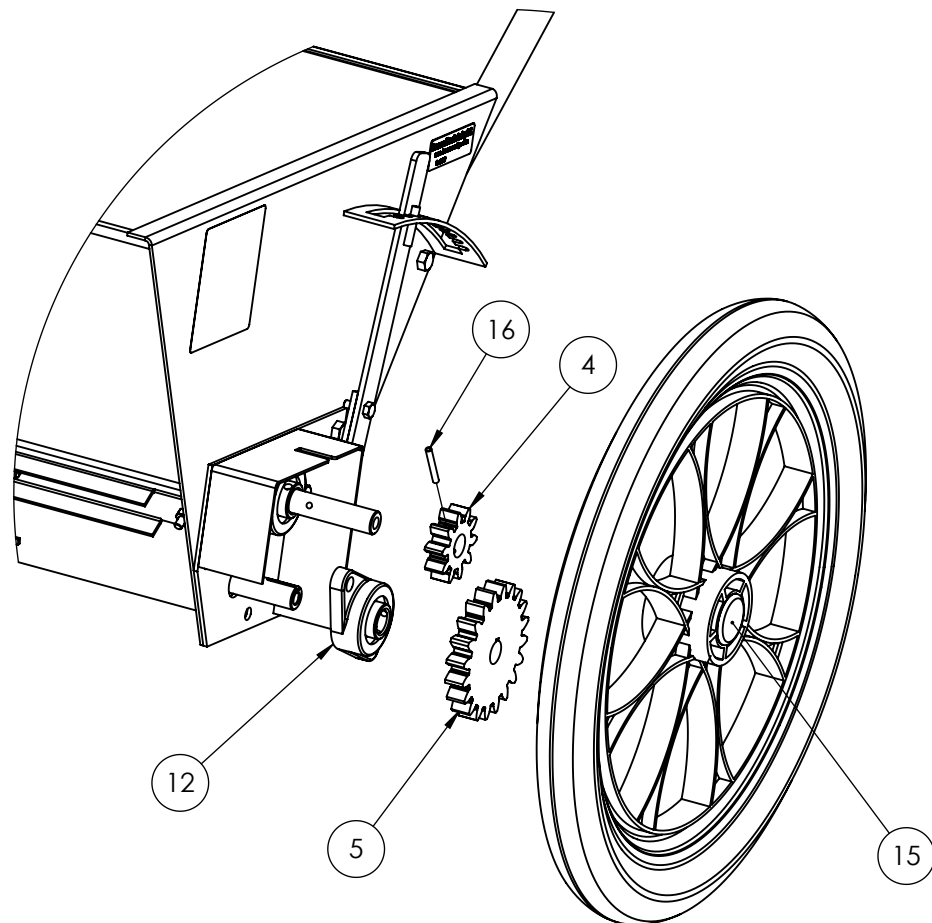
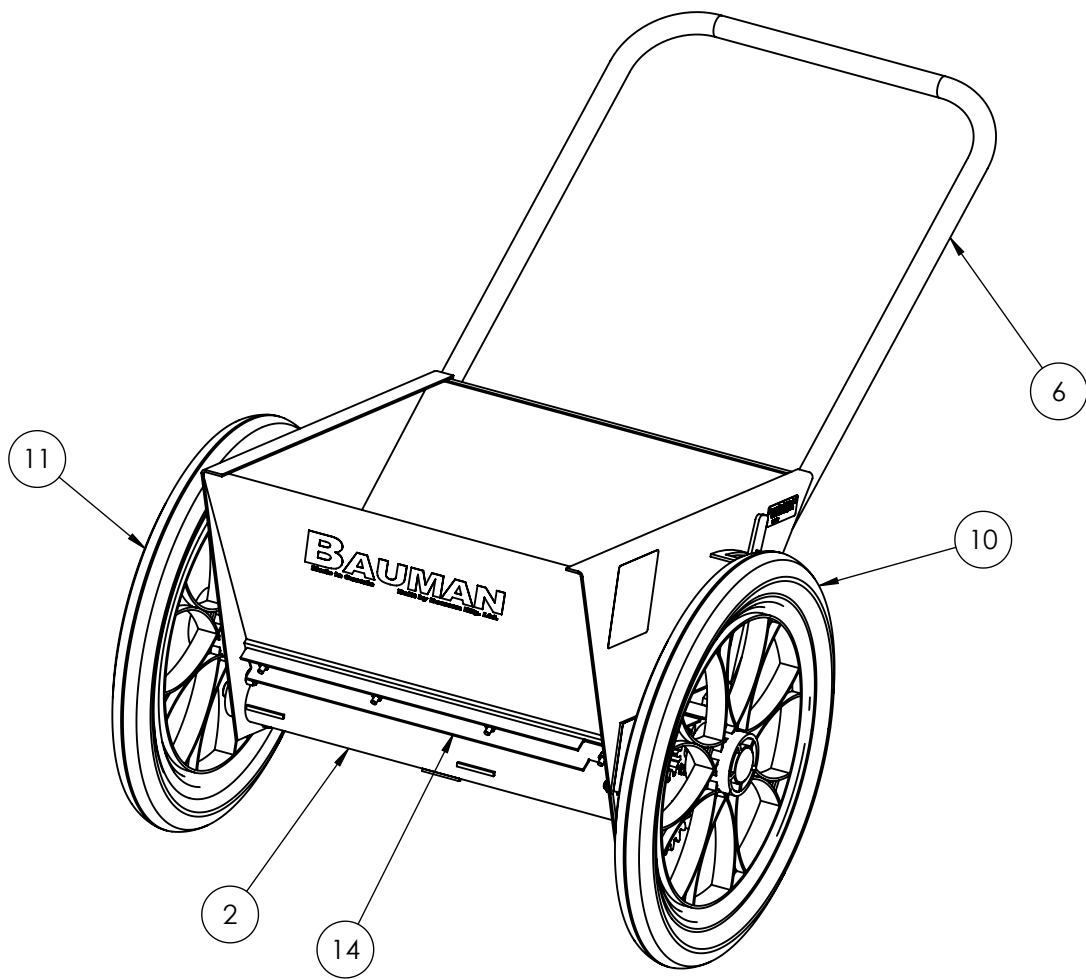
The operator of the 220 Bauman Sidewalk Sander assumes responsibility for the safety of all persons and property within their vicinity. The operator must see to it that all persons (particularly children) stay out of the path of the sander, as well as any of the moving components within the machine. The 220 sander has been designed for single-person operation, do not allow others to ride or sit on the sander at any time.

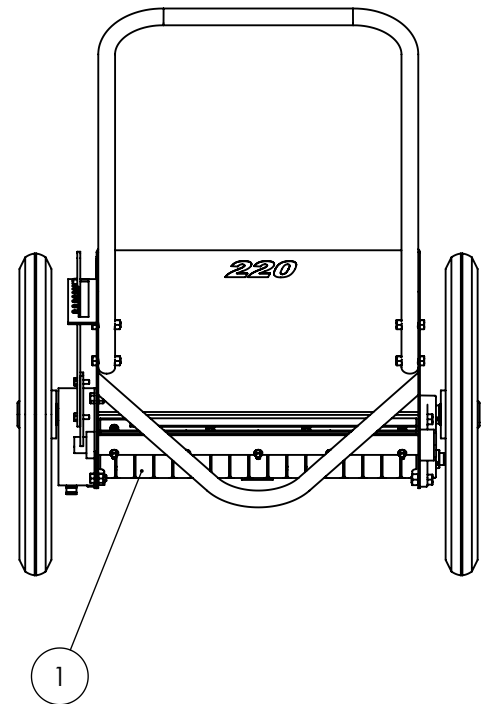
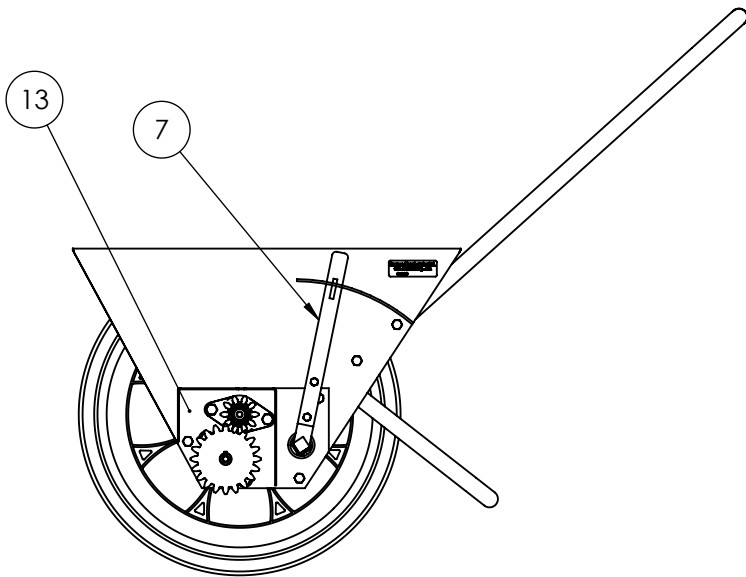
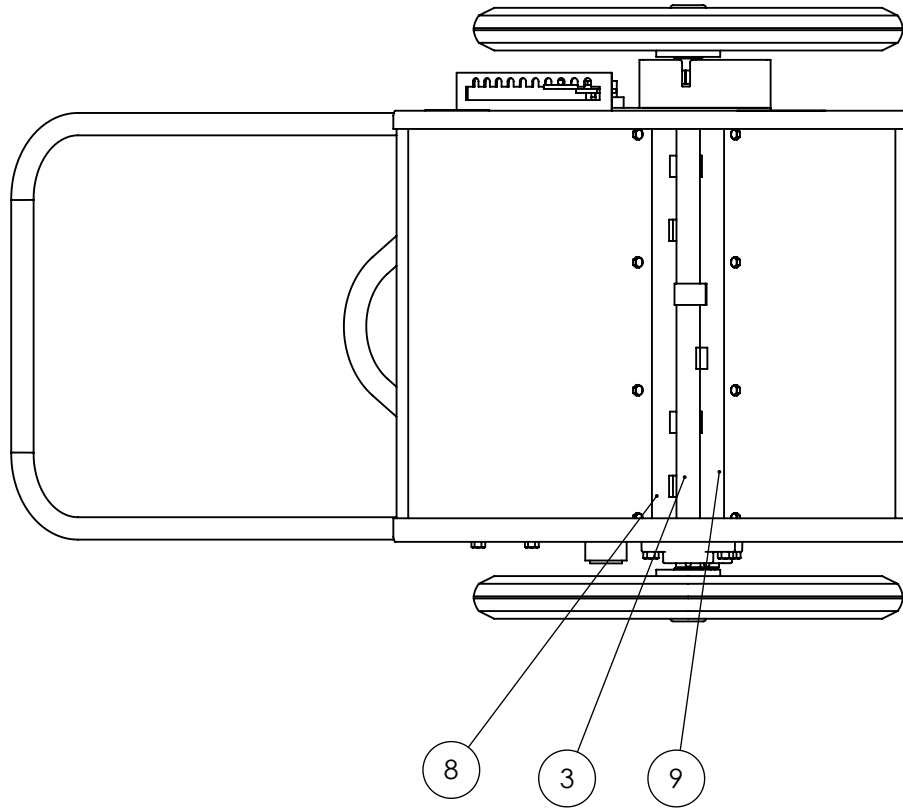


The danger and warning labels on our equipment are for the safety of the operator and bystanders. Always read and obey these labels. It is the responsibility of the operator that all guards are in place and attached properly, and that no one reaches into the hopper while the machine is in operation. Rotating shafts can cause serious injury.
