

SAFETY





This symbol is the standard safety symbol. You will find it on most of the decals on your equipment. It is also used throughout this manual.

This symbol is used mainly to draw your attention and to warn you of possible dangers and/or potential injuries.

As the owner of this equipment, you are responsible for the safety of its users and those who are responsible for its maintenance. You and any other person using or performing maintenance on this equipment must be familiar with its operation and maintenance, as well as the safety measures contained in this manual. Having safe working practices guarantees a safer work environment.

Do not in any way modify this equipment. Unauthorized modifications could impair the proper functioning and/or safety of this equipment and possibly affect its useful life as well

General Safety Measures

Read and understand all operating and safety instructions and guidelines contained in this manual prior to using, maintaining or adjusting the equipment.

Ensure all safety guards and shields are properly installed prior to using the equipment.

Always have a first aid kit within reach, and know how to use it

Always have a fire extinguisher within reach, and know how to use it.

Know how to operate all controls, stop the rock rake and disengage all controls with haste.

Avoid wearing loose, cumbersome or torn clothing when you are near the rock rake.

Be extremely cautious while servicing or while near high pressure hydraulic systems. Ensure all components are fully sealed and in good working order prior to operating the equipment.

Operating Safety

Lower the rock rake, stop the tractor's engine, set controls to neutral, engage the emergency brake, remove the tractor's ignition key and wait for all moving parts to come to a full stop prior to adjusting, detaching or servicing the rock rake.

Keep hands, feet, hair and all clothing away from all moving parts and/or rotating parts.

Do not remove protective guards or shields. Ensure they are in place and properly attached.

Clear the area of all people, especially small children, prior to engaging the rock rake and/or the tractor.

Do not operate and do not leave the engine running in a non ventilated area.

Never perform adjustments, cleaning, and unclogging, greasing or other maintenance rock rake while engine is running.

Stay well away from the rock rake while it is in operation to avoid being hit by a flying rock and/or debris that may be ejected into the air.

Maintenance Safety

Lower the rock rake, stop the tractor's engine, set controls to neutral, engage the emergency brake, remove the tractor's ignition key and wait for all moving parts to come to a full stop prior to adjusting, detaching or servicing the rock rake.

Regularly check to make sure the bolts and screws are tight, and perform regular maintenance to keep the device in good working order.

Carefully examine the device to make certain that there is no damage.

Do not in any way modify this equipment, its components or its intended use. Fabrication S.Houle Inc. will not be held responsible should breakage or injury occur as a result of using any non-approved parts or accessories.



OPERATION

To the New Operator or Owner

The Fabrication SHOULE WD-10B Rock Rakes are designed to efficiently windrow rocks from 2 to 12 inches (50 to 300 mm) diameter. Many of the features incorporated into this machine are the result of suggestions made by customers like you.

It is the owner or operator's responsibility to read this manual carefully to learn how to operate the machine safely and how to set it to provide maximum efficiency. Safety is everyone's business. By following safe operating practices, a safe environment is provided for the operator and bystanders.

By following the operating instructions in conjunction with a good maintenance program, your Rock Rake will provide many years of trouble-free service.

Operation

Familiarize yourself with the various settings of the Rock Rake that are designed to allow the machine to work in a variety of field conditions. Field experience will indicate the combination of machine and operating condition to give a quality job. This section will cover the interaction of the field condition and machine setting

Rock Density

Rate the rock density as light, medium or heavy. Normally the machine ground speed will decrease as the rock density increases to insure that the teeth on the auger have the opportunity to make contact with each rock.

Soil Condition

Dry, firm ground is ideally suited for raking. Soft ground will require adjustments to the angling of the spiral drum to insure that the soil can fall between the teeth on the right end and not be moved into the windrow. Wet soil will ball up with the rocks and can plug the teeth. Give the soil more time to dry before raking.

It is recommended that the teeth on the left end of the drum penetrate the ground about 2 inches (50mm). Soft soil conditions require a lighter floatation; Hard soil a heavier floatation.

Auger RPM

Changing the engine speed changes the auger RPM. It is recommended that the PTO/Auger speed always be run at rated RPM and the ground speed be varied by changing gears in the tractor.

Forward Speed

The recommended ground speed varies from 2 to 6 mph (3,2 - 9,7 km/h) and is determined by rock density and size. When you see that rocks are being missed behind the machine, slow down. Increase the speed when the rock density decreases.

Transporting

Be sure the SMV sign is facing to the rear. Clean the SMV sign, lights, and reflectors

Always use the hazard flashers on the tractor when transporting

Do not exceed 20 mph (32 km/h) when transporting. Never exceed a safe travel speed. Slow down when cornering or on rough roads.




MAINTENANCE

Maintenance


Wipe the grease fittings with a clean cloth before greasing. Lubricate all greasers for every eight hours of operation.



Verify drive chain tension after first eight hours of operation, and then once a month. The chain can move 1 /2".




During adjustment of the torque limiter, the springs must be compressed to length of 1 5/16", which should be periodically verified. Warning: if the springs are compressed to a length inferior to 1 5/16", there is a risk of damage to the gearbox and the drive chain components.




Check the gearbox oil level once a month. Perform oil change once a year, using gear oil grade 80W90.


The auger teeth have been designed to be easily inverted when one side becomes too worn. To invert, remove the bolts. Turn the tooth over and simply bolt it back into place. While facing the rock rake, place the tooth on the left side of its support.

Warranty



Fabrication S.Houle limited guarantee on agricultural and commercial equipment

Fabrication SHoule Inc guaranties every new farm and commercial product of the manufacturer SHoule against any defect of material and manufacturing, within the framework of a normal use, during one year after the date of retail purchase SHoule will guarantee its product for (1) year, on parts and imperfection of manufacturing This Limited Guarantee will apply only to equipments made by S.Houle.

EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES WHICH ARE NOT MADE BY S HOULE ARE GUARANTEED ONLY IN THE MEASURE WHICH THE GUARANTEE OF the ORIGINAL MANUFACTURER DETERMINES AND APPROVES THAT THERE IS A MANUFACTURING DEFECT.

During the period limited by guarantee indicated above, any defect in the material (equipment) or in the manufacturing of any equipment fabricated by S.Houle will be repaired or replaced without responsibility by an authorized independent retailer An authorized retailer has to make the repair under guarantee or the replacement of parts The costs of labour must be approved by manufacturing SHoule before beginning (undertaking) the works otherwise these could be totally refused, according to the politics (policy) of working refund (repayment) of S.Houle SHoule reserves the right to supply parts, for replacement which he (it) considers appropriate.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BUYER: This limited guarantee requires (demands) the appropriate maintenance and the overhauls of the agricultural or commercial equipment such as indicated in operator manual supplied with the new equipment The cost of the regular maintenance or the required services is the responsibility of the buyer The buyer has to keep his invoices which prove that the maintenance was made

The limited guarantee may be revoked (dismissed) by Fabrication S.Houle if the above mentioned conditions (requirements) are not respected.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Guarantees WILL NOT APPLY on:

- 2 Any agricultural or commercial equipment which the identification number or serial number or the trade names were changed or removed.

- 5 Any equipment used for field demonstrations by a retailer not approved by S.Houle The guarantee will be to the discretion of S.Houle or any other demonstration.
- 6 Any defect which was caused (according to the judgment of S.Houle) by the operation of the equipment without submitting itself to the standard (in the standard) procedures of exploitation (operation) described in operator manual.
- 7 The guarantee on tires is the responsibility of the manufacturer of the respective product
- 8 Cost of the transport, if necessary, to transport to the retailer S.Houle.
- 9 In no case the responsibility of S. Houle can exceed the cost of the product
- 10 SHoule will be subjected in no circumstances to compensate, whoever it is, for the loss of income for a discontinued equipment, for a time of the repairs no matter the reason for this breakdown.
- 11 The costs of estimation or the diagnostic and the overtime of work for the repair are not covered under this limited guarantee policy.
- 12 The depreciation caused by the normal wear, the lack of reasonable and appropriate maintenance, the misuse, and\or the lack of protection during warehousing.


