
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
PREPARATION



A) Examine the tractor for possible locations for the valve and joystick control.

NOTES: Choose a location that will protect the valve and allow the hoses and cables to be connected. The location should protect the cables from heat above 225° F and physical damage such as crushing or pinching. Choose a location for the cables to pass through the floor board (if necessary) being careful not to damage anything under the floor such as electrical wires or oil lines.

A) Choose a convenient and comfortable place to mount the joystick control. The joystick control is shown mounted on the Westendorf control stand however you may choose to mount the control along the side of the cab, in the console, or some other convenient spot.
